This summer, we have already held 7 stewardship events where over 100 volunteers have put in 250 hours to help mulch and maintain previous planting areas. - October 19 and 20: we will be back at Rouge National Urban Park at our 2023 site to add another 2,000 trees. 600 volunteers are required.

Our Impact in 2024 so far

- 5,750 trees and shrubs planted at Bruce's Mill Park and Monarch Park
- 150 wildflowers planted at Monarch Park
- 2,150 volunteer shifts completed
- 6,600 hours of planting, mulching and maintenance in our natural spaces

Preparing the land for 2025

Our forester is in the process of preparing our 2025 planting site by mowing and ploughing the land. This will help to break up the sod and increase nutrient availability for the future trees. A temporary cover crop will also be seeded and planted to stabilize the soil and decrease weed growth.
